

## Under this agreement for 2022 Columboola EEC will receive



- Develop a new staff induction program that incorporates mandatory certification for leading outdoor learning activities;
- Enhance understanding of Indigenous perspectives through targeted staff development and centre based initiatives;
- Drive program innovation through professional exchanges with other outdoor and environmental education centres.

## **Our initiatives include**

- New teacher induction to include specialised high ropes training facilitated by The Outdoor Education Consultants (TOEC) 2 x \$1200pp = \$2400;
- New teacher induction to include Bushwalking Qualification facilitated by Tallebudgera Outdoor & Environmental Education Centre (TOEEC) 1 x \$1300;
- Cultural Competency Training completed by all centre staff facilitated by Tallebudgera Outdoor & Environmental Education Centre (TOEEC) 6 x \$150pp = \$900;
- Visitations to other O&EE Centre's to foster program innovation and enhancement to drive best practice \$1033.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing fully qualified staff to support high risk outdoor learning activities;
- Program offerings that include Duke of Ed Bushwalking qualification (Bronze);
- Further developing staff understanding of and connection with Indigenous perspectives;
- Increasing our staff's cultural understanding and awareness;
- Providing teaching and learning practices that further promote Indigenous education;
- Further developing program options to meet the needs of identified target groups.
